



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
ON COOPERATION BETWEEN  
SATKYNBAY TENTISHEV MEMORIAL ASIAN MEDICAL INSTITUTE  
&  
ARISE MEDICAL ACADEMY**

Satkynbay Tentishev memorial Asian Medical Institute, hereinafter referred to as AsMI, represented by the rector Prof. Selpiev Toychubek Tulekovich, acting on the basis of the Charter of AsMI, and Arise Medical Academy Represented by Director, Dr Khaleel Arise Medical Academy Both referred to as Parties.

**PREAMBLE**

We, AsMI and Arise Medical Academy, in order to improve the relationship between the two organizations based on the principles of reciprocity and equality, and in order to further develop mutually beneficial scientific development, agree to long-term cooperation.

**SUBJECT OF THE MEMORANDUM**

**Article 1.**

The parties will promote scientific and technical cooperation on the basis of principles and mutual benefit, creating the necessary organizational, financial and economic conditions for this.

**Article 2.**

Cooperation under this Memorandum will be carried out in accordance with the legislation of the "Parties". The Parties also proceed from the fact that no actions within the framework of this Memorandum should infringe any powers of the rights of any of the Parties.

**Article 3.**

**Activity:**

**Education**

- joint exchange of students and teaching staff on academic mobility programs;
- creation of joint educational programs residency, postgraduate and doctoral studies;
- joint creation of online programs;

**Clinic:**

joint internships at partner universities for students (residency, postgraduate, doctoral studies);

- conducting practical seminars for senior students and teachers;
- exchange of available video materials;
- provision of assistance to the teaching staff on advanced training programs in medicine;

**Study:**

- conducting joint research, including joint funding of grants;
- publishing joint research results in international journals;
- scientific leadership of graduate students and doctoral students;
- development of exchange programs for teaching staff, including research students;
- providing online access to research articles and educational information to each of the parties.

**Other:**

- creation of development programs aimed at development potential;
- organization and implementation of joint events (symposia, seminars, round tables, conferences and olympiads);
- participation in the events of the partner;
- creation of a consortium uniting efforts aimed at solving issues in modern medicine and scientific research.

**Article 4.**

If the Parties make a decision on joint participation in a certain project (joint activity), the Parties may sign an agreement on joint activity, which will determine the shares of participation of each of the Parties, stages (terms) for fulfilling obligations, the procedure for distributing income and expenses and other conditions, relevant to the implementation of a joint project.

**Article 5.**

Funding and financial agreements: The parties may establish common funds for the implementation of common programs. Financial agreements between partner institutions may vary depending on the nature of the specific activity on the basis of mutual agreement.

**Article 6.**

Any of the Parties can initiate joint specific scientific and technical works, the content of these scientific and technical works and forms of relationship, its economic and organizational conditions can be agreed on the basis of separate agreements.

**Article 7.**

In the event of implementation of joint educational and research programs, the Parties will provide each other with the opportunity to jointly use educational laboratories, libraries and other resources free of charge in accordance with the plans (schedules) agreed by the Parties.

**Article 8.**

The validity period of this Memorandum is 5 years from the date of signing and comes into force from the date of signing by both Parties.

### Article 9.

Work to be performed at the time of the termination of this Memorandum will be permitted to be completed as scheduled, unless otherwise agreed on this matter.

### Article 10.

The parties will use the information and documents obtained under this Memorandum only for the implementation of this Memorandum and will not disclose this information to a third party without the written consent of the Party that provided this information. This provision will continue to apply after the termination of this Memorandum.

### Article 11.

Termination (termination) of this Memorandum does not release the Parties from the need to fulfill all their obligations under this Memorandum, as well as obligations for joint projects that arose during the validity of this Memorandum and were not fulfilled at the time of its termination and does not relieve the Parties from liability for failure to comply and / or improper fulfillment of any of these obligations.


### Article 12.
